## state affordable housing tax credit



## overview

In 2024, with the passage of House Bill 24-1434, CHFA introduced a new approach to its allocation of state Affordable Housing Tax Credits (AHTC or state credit). This legislation increases CHFA's state credit allocation authority by \$20 million in 2024; \$16 million in 2025; \$12 million in 2026 and 2027; \$16 million in 2028; and \$20 million in 2029-2031. The new state credit is also "accelerated," which increases the pace at which investors may claim the new credit resources.

CHFA also allocates \$10 million of existing state credit annually through 2031. These resources are ratably claimed over six years and are known as "standard" state credit.
